



Green Fins Code of Conduct

"To protect and conserve coral reefs by establishing and implementing environmentally friendly guidelines to promote a sustainable diving tourism industry."

As a Green Fins Member You Are Expected To:

- 1 Melaksanakan misi Green Fins**
Adopt Green Fins mission statement
- 2 Menunjukkan kesepakatan yang telah diadopsi**
Display the adopted Green Fins agreement for the public to see
- 3 Mematuhi "Panduan Selam dan Snorkeling Ramah Lingkungan" serta menjadi contoh yang baik bagi wisatawan**
Adhere to the 'Green Fins' Friendly Diving and Snorkelling Guidelines and act as a responsible role model for guests
- 4 Mengikuti kegiatan pembersihan bawah laut (underwater cleanups) secara teratur**
Participate in regular underwater cleanups at dive operator selected sites
- 5 Mengikuti program pemasangan dan pengembangan mooring buoy, serta menggunakan mooring atau jangkar yang diletakkan dengan tangan**
Participate in the development and implementation of a mooring buoy program and actively use moorings, drift or hand place anchors for boats
- 6 Melarang penjualan karang dan biota laut lainnya**
Prohibit the sales of corals and other marine life at the dive operation
- 7 Mengikuti program pemantauan terumbu karang dan melaporkan data hasil pemantauan ke bank data terumbu karang di wilayah tersebut**
Participate in regular coral reef monitoring and report coral reef monitoring data to a regional coral reef database
- 8 Menyediakan fasilitas pembuangan sampah yang memadai**
Provide adequate garbage facilities on board facility's vessel and deal with responsibly
- 9 Melaksanakan kebijakan Minimisasi Limbah**
Operate under a 'minimum discharge' policy
- 10 Mematuhi segala bentuk undang-undang, hukum, serta adat istiadat lingkungan hidup yang berlaku**
Abide by all local, regional, national and international environmental laws, regulations and customs
- 11 Menyediakan informasi tentang Panduan Penyelaman dan Snorkeling Ramah Lingkungan untuk wisatawan pada saat sebelum menyelam**
Provide guests with an explanation of Green Fins 'Friendly Diving and Snorkelling Guidelines' in pre dive briefings
- 12 Menyediakan pelatihan, briefing, atau literatur bagi karyawan dan wisatawan terkait aktivitas penyelaman, snorkeling, berperahu, interaksi dengan biota laut, serta kegiatan rekreasi laut lainnya yang berwawasan lingkungan**
Provide training, briefing or literature for employees and guests regarding good environmental practices for snorkelling, diving, boating, marine wildlife interaction and other marine recreational activities
- 13 Menyediakan materi kampanye peduli lingkungan bagi para karyawan dan wisatawan (buku, pamflet, buku identifikasi ikan, dan lain-lain)**
Provide staff and guests with public awareness and environmental materials (ID books, pamphlets etc)
- 14 Menyediakan informasi mengenai daerah perlindungan laut serta hukum-hukum dan peraturan lingkungan**
Provide guests with information on local Marine Protected Areas, environmental rules and regulations
- 15 Melaksanakan kebijakan "Dilarang Sentuh" dengan ketat untuk semua aktivitas penyelaman dan snorkeling**
Promote a strict 'No Touch' policy for all reef diving and snorkelling
